Dear Parents

**Re: Proposed China Excursion 2016**

I am currently after an expression of interest of students wanting to attend an excursion in October 2016, a 13 day tour of China.

**Planned excursion**

1. *Itinerary*
  - Attached is a brochure of the itinerary of the proposed tour.
  - If there is enough interest a representative from Educational World Tours (EWT) will come to the school and address both parents and students about this opportunity, including detailing of the payment plan.
2. *Students involved*
  - This opportunity is open to the current Year 8 and Year 9 students. These students will be in Year 10 and 11 in 2014. In October 2016 Year 11 will have finished their preliminary course and be ready to start their HSC course therefore it is a perfect time to take the trip.
3. *Cost*
  - The cost of the **2014** tour was \$3195.00; Government Taxes and Airline Surcharges - \$449.46, Visa Application Fee - \$98.00, QBE Insurance - \$99.00 (Nil Excess)/\$74.00 (\$100 Excess) being a total of \$3841.46/3816.46. The EWT representative will give a firm price for the 2016 tour when she addresses those that are interested.
4. *Rationale*
  - This is an opportunity that would enhance student's view of the world outside Condobolin.
  - With two years notice students have time to save money for the trip, they will have two Birthdays and Christmases in this time that maybe they can forfeit presents for money for the trip!
  - Once you have made the decision to go (after the address from the EWT representative), EWT will need a \$400 deposit and the rest is paid on a negotiated payment plan.
5. *Closing Date of expression of interest*
  - Students need to have the signed interest form returned to school by Friday 31<sup>st</sup> October 2014.

Remember this is only an expression of interest to allow me to organise with Education World Travel to come and address you. Therefore, if there is genuine interest please fill out the form.
