Primary Initiatives 2016 With Kindergarten being our biggest Year – 9 students – efforts have been made to strive for the best outcomes for all primary students during morning Literacy and Numeracy periods. This year the children will divide into 3 groups for the first 2 periods, with Mrs Dillon focussing of Kinder and Year 1, Miss Pearce focussing on Years 2, 3 and 4 and Miss Ward working with the Years 5 and 6 students Of course Mrs Dillon's K/ 1/ 2 group is also housed in a new room this year. They occupy the Curriba School buildings with Ms Bell's office for Learning Support immediately beside them. The old K/ 1/ 2 Room has now become the Library. All the extra work from Mrs Dillon and supporters, which made this possible, is most praiseworthy.

A couple of unusual events occur on Thursday morning. NRL program kicks off at 10 am for the primary students and involves the secondary students at 11am.

Meanwhile secondary students have a VC at 10 am to check out the work of an Australian man who hopes to be on a Mars mission with NASA in 2020. Interesting stuff.

LAST, PBL and CAPA Another initiative along-side the primary shake up us the thinking and energy being devoted to the creation and resourcing of our PBL room. This initiative occupies Ms Bell's support room. It is stocked with plenty of "thinking toys" which students are permitted to use in an effort to regroup and redirect their positive energies. We are all most pleased to see Ms Bell and Mrs Hayward re-join our staff 2 – 3 days per week providing valuable *Learning and Support Teaching* to a selection of our students.

Mrs Hayward is also timetabled to teach Art and Music for the majority of the school.

All of our **Secondary Staff** are back on deck in 2016.

I would like to thank the teachers and ancillary staff for their conscientious efforts during our near week of inservice time.

I wish to express my enthusiasm for the great work they will do in partnership with students and for the outstanding learning year we hope to share in 2016.
