CSI HITS TULLIBIGEAL



Last Thursday students in Years 3 to 6 were involved in a crime scene investigation. After recess they came back to their classroom where they were placed in a mystery murder scene. They were placed in groups where they had to work collaboratively to solve the murder and put the criminal behind bars.

Once in their groups they were shown a number of suspects and given a background scenario. They then had to pull on their gloves and investigate the scene by using magnetic powder to find prints, find the weapon used, cloth fibres and any other relevant information. Once they had enough evidence on a suspect they were given a warrant to go and conduct an interview and search their room if necessary. They had to use ipads to collect evidence and record their interviews.

The students thoroughly enjoyed using all the equipment and eliminating suspects as they worked through it.



In the end Mrs Dillon was arrested and charged with the murder of Miss Pearce, as she did not cover her tracks well enough and had left cloth fibres at the scene and her blood stained scarf was found hidden in her office.

We would like to thank Miss Goldthorpe for all of her time and effort with the investigation and sharing her cool scientific knowledge.




