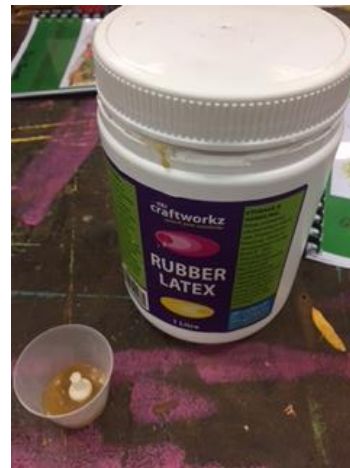
### Aeroplane Jelly competition
