While at school, masks or face coverings are recommended in all indoor settings for:

- all students in Year 7 and above
- all staff in school settings.

Unfortunately non-essential visitors are not permitted in schools. Some visitors are permitted in schools based on the guidelines that follow.

Parents and carers must follow their school's advice regarding changes to drop off and pick up including staying in the car when dropping off and picking up children if safe to do so.

Parents should:

- maintain physical distancing by avoiding gathering outside of school gates
- remain outside of school grounds
- follow mask-wearing requirements and sign in using the Service NSW QR code when entering the school.
- Parents and carers are not to enter school grounds without arranging a meeting prior. This can be arranged by calling through to our front office staff on 6972 9105

Canteen will continue Wednesdays however we do ask that only one person run the canteen and that younger siblings should not attend. Please contact the school if you need to discuss this further.

On returning to the school I have noticed there has been some changes including our library which has been transformed into a wonderful learning space. 


