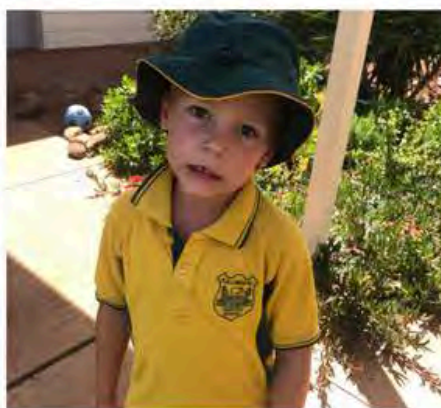

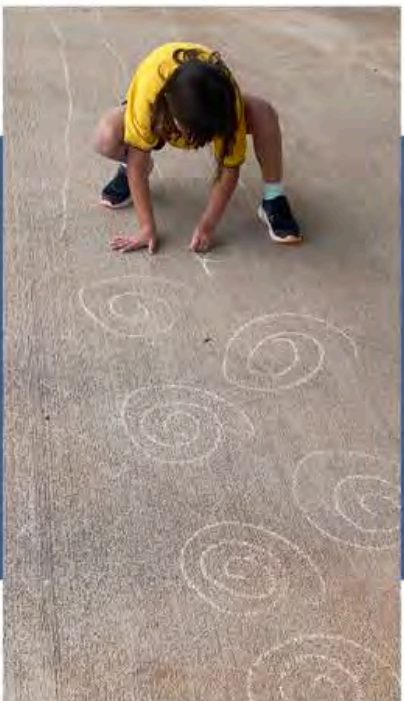
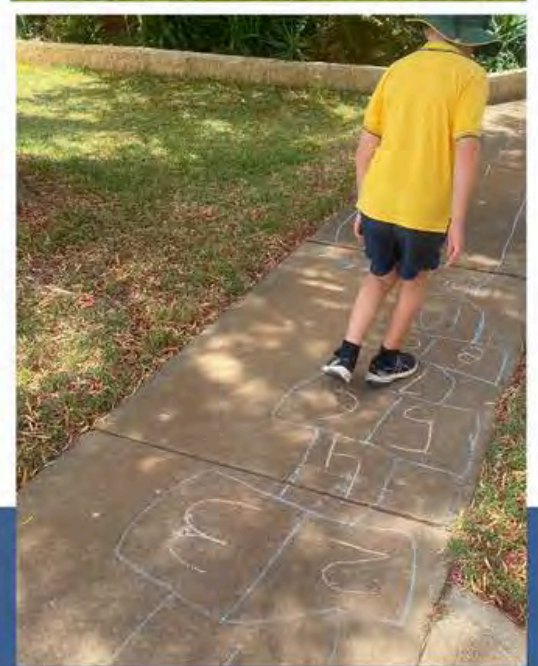
KINDER TRANSITION 2024

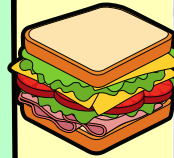

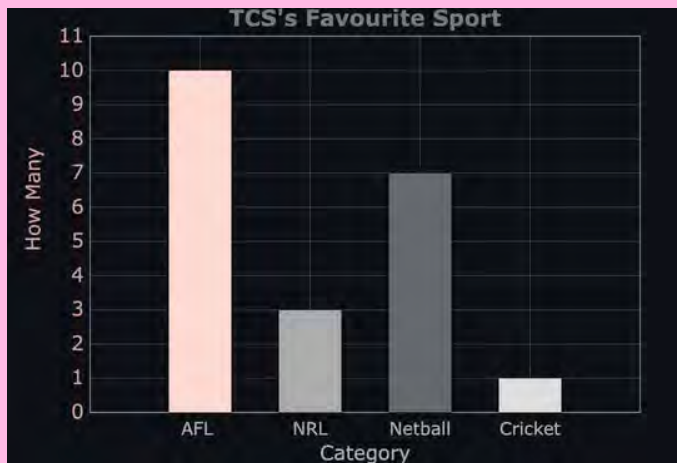

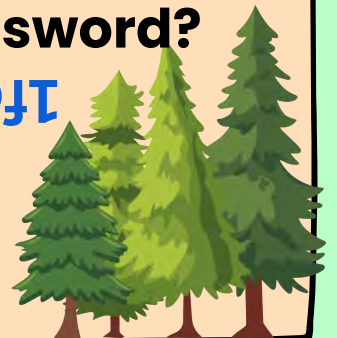

K/1 Hsie



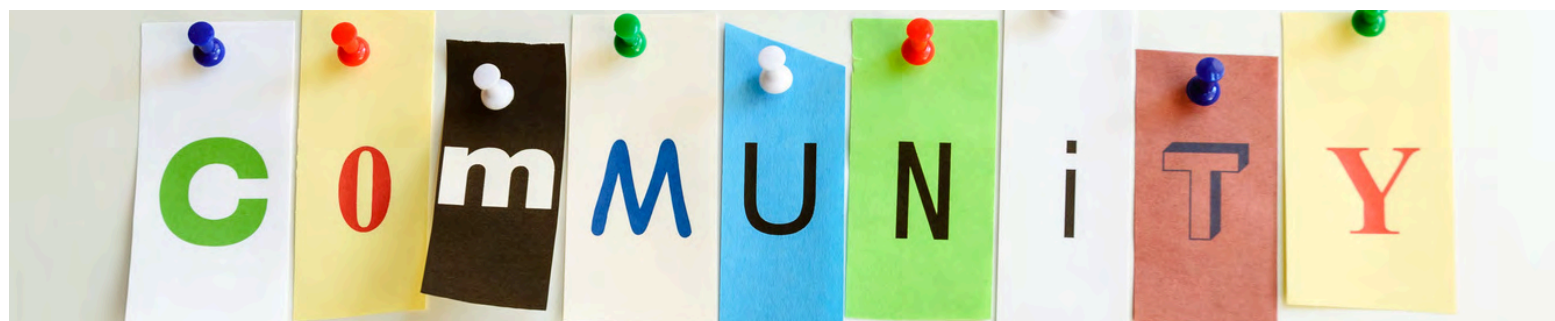
